Hunter Stevens, at an early age, expressed a gift and a love of fashion. She is known for her impromptu fashion shows and complimentary comments and advice on your "fashions."

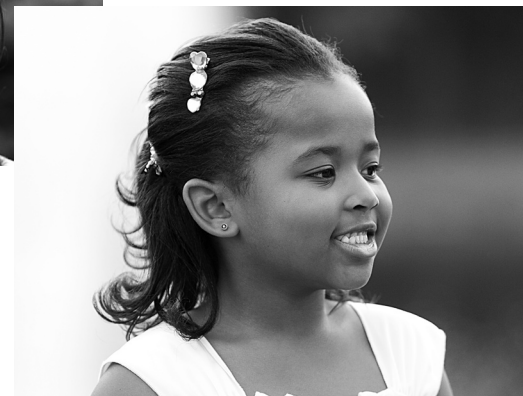
